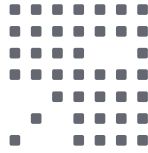

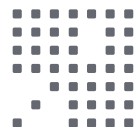

The Migrant Resource Centre (MRC) at the Ministry of Labour and Social Affairs in Baghdad is an information centre where you can receive information about migration. A team of counsellors raises awareness on irregular migration, the risks involved and its consequences faced by individuals and their families. They also provide migration advice to migrants enabling them to be fully informed, assessing the pros and cons of migration and finally supporting the clients in making informed and realistic migration decision i.e. either to stay in the country or migrate legally.
